

Dylan Goodson Relief Scene or Human Figure

Relief Option - Florida River Scene

This year's relief scene will be a Florida river scene featuring a manatee in the water and a house overlooking the palm and cypress tree lined riverbanks. In addition to Dylan's techniques for carving the house and landscape, bring your wood burner so you can learn Dylan's technique for creating a screened in porch. This technique actually simplifies the process of carving the house, allowing you to create a highly detailed house with ease. Each student will be provided with a DVD covering the power carving techniques that Dylan uses since there's never enough time to cover this fully during class. Project size will probably be 8" by 10" by 2" thick.



Figure Option - Carve a 7" tall Cowboy Figure

Learn how to carve a realistic figure from a bandsaw cutout. During the class Dylan will focus on teaching you about human anatomy and how to efficiently carve the shapes of a realistic figure. The small size will make it easier for the carving to be completed in the class, but will also make details such as the face and hands harder to carve.

Dylan will teach you how to deal with the smaller details through the appropriate use of simplification along with careful carving techniques. Therefore, this is a great project for anyone that is looking to transition from caricatures to realistic figures or anyone that is ready to start creating figures of their own design. Don't worry about trying to carve the rope as we'll be doing that out of wire or string, however plenty of time will be spent on how to carve the details and wrinkles in the clothing.

Full size or intermediate size carving tools are Dylan's preferred choice (particularly for relief) but are not required. Carving stands will be provided during the class. Roughout prices will range from \$25 to \$55.
